

RULES

13th International Scientific Conference entitled "Faces of Prosperity. Innovations." Gdańsk, May 23, 2026

I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The organizer of the 13th International Scientific Conference entitled "Faces of Prosperity. Innovations" is the Powiślańska Academy of Applied Sciences with its headquarters in Kwidzyn (82-500) at ul. 11 Listopada 29, registered under number 166 in the Register of Non-Public Universities kept by the Minister of Science and Higher Education; hereinafter referred to as the Organizer.
2. Participants in the event may include academic staff, doctoral students, students, invited guests, and company representatives who meet all the requirements set out in part II of the Participation Regulations.
3. The footnotes to these Regulations form an integral part of the application for participation for the 13th International Scientific Conference entitled "Faces of Prosperity. Innovations." and are binding on all participants.
4. Submitting an online application (using the form attached to the invitation) to the Organizer is tantamount to the Participant's acceptance of these Regulations and constitutes a form of commitment between the parties.
5. The conference is organized as part of the international week "International Wekek'26".

II

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. The condition for participation in the Conference is to register for the Conference by completing the registration form available on the Conference website.
2. Registration requires the Participant to provide their personal data, i.e., first name, last name, email address, e-mail address, and other necessary information.
3. Participants who plan to prepare an oral presentation are required to register its topic and abstract in the registration form. The titles of the papers and their abstracts should be prepared in Polish or English, with a maximum length of 3000 characters including spaces. The scope of the study should be described, the methods used in the study should be listed, the main conclusions and possible research assumptions for further work or practical application should be provided. A maximum of 5 keywords.
4. The following types of participation in the event are distinguished:
 - a) Active participant with a presentation and article for publication;
 - b) Active participant with a presentation without an article for publication;
 - c) Passive participant (without a presentation) with an article for publication;



- d) Passive participant (without a presentation) without an article for publication.
5. Oral presentations/scientific articles may have a maximum of 3 authors.
6. Participants are required to register the topic of their presentation on time and to make any corrections or changes to their work on time. Full registration takes place after receiving an email informing them of the acceptance or rejection of the topic. If no email is received regarding the submitted topic within 7 days of its registration, the participant is required to contact the Organizing Committee to explain the delay.

III CONFERENCE RULES

1. The deadline for online registration for the Conference is:
 - a) March 30, 2026 – for participants with a presentation (active participation),
 - b) April 30, 2026 – for participants without presentations (passive participation).After these dates, online registration will no longer be available, unless the Organizer extends the registration period.
2. The right to participate in the Conference is granted to researchers, doctoral students, students, invited guests and company representatives, other interested entities and individuals.
3. The Organizer sets the Conference schedule and has the right to make changes to it, even on the day the event takes place, including the right to change the schedule and order of events.
4. The Organizer is not responsible for Participants' belongings that may be lost, damaged, or stolen during the Conference.
5. Participants bear full responsibility for any damage they cause on the premises where the Conference activities are conducted.
6. The Participant shall be fully responsible for all materials and information presented by them, including, but not limited to, the name/logo, banners, stands, roll-ups, presentations, and advertising materials.
7. Participants undertake to comply with safety rules, including fire safety rules, as well as the Organizer's organizational and technical instructions and orders.

IV PAYMENTS

1. Participation in the conference is:
 - a) **paid for active participants with publication – PLN 450; payment should be made to the following bank account: 18 1090 2620 0000 0001 5904 2117 - SANTANDER BANK POLSKA S.A. - SWIFT CODE: WBKPPLPP, with the title "Conference fee, first and last name";** (employees, guests of International Week 2026, and students of the Powiślańska Academy of Applied Sciences are exempt from the conference fee)
 - b) **completely free for active participants without publications (with a paper) and passive participants.**
2. All travel, accommodation, and material costs necessary for the presentation of the paper are covered by the participant.
3. Each active participant will receive a certificate of participation with the topic of their presentation.
4. Coffee breaks and a meal are provided during the event.

V WITHDRAWAL FROM PARTICIPATION

VI CONSENT TO USE OF IMAGE

1. During the Conference, the Organizer may conduct photo sessions and film the event for the purposes of documentation, promotion, and advertising of the Organizer.
2. Participation in the Conference is tantamount to expressing free, unlimited consent, in terms of quantity, time, and territory, to the free use, processing, reproduction and repeated distribution of the participant's image captured in photographs taken during the Conference without the need for each time approval, for informational, promotional and advertising purposes of the Conference. The above consent is tantamount to the fact that photographs and recordings made during the Conference may be posted on the Internet, including, in particular, on the Conference website at <https://konferencja.powislanska.edu.pl/> and on open and closed websites and social media such as Facebook, Instagram, etc.

VII PERSONAL DATA

1. The Organizer is the administrator of the Participants' personal data.
2. The Conference Organizer does not transfer, sell, or lend the collected personal data of Participants to other persons or institutions.
3. The personal data provided by the Participant is treated as confidential information and is used only and exclusively for the purposes of communication between the Participant and the Conference Organizer.
4. The Participant's personal data contained in the Conference registration form collected by the Organizer is processed for the purpose of conducting the Conference in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations, including the creation of a list of Participants.
5. By registering, the Participant consents to the processing of their personal data for the purposes of conducting the Conference in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations.
6. The Participant's personal data will not be transferred to other data controllers without their knowledge and consent.
7. Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary to participate in the Conference. Data subjects have the right to access their personal data and the right to rectify, delete, restrict processing, the right to transfer data, the right to object, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
8. The organizer takes all appropriate security measures in accordance with the law as well as generally accepted principles for protecting the confidentiality of information.

VIII FINAL PROVISIONS

1. Any disputes that may arise from participation in the Conference shall be settled by the court competent for the Organizer's registered office, unless the provisions of generally applicable law provide otherwise.
2. The Conference is a closed event and does not constitute a mass event within the meaning of the Act of March 23, 2007 on the safety of mass events (Journal of Laws 2009, item 504).
3. In matters not covered by these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.
4. These Regulations shall enter into force on the date of their publication on the Conference Website.
5. The Organizer has the right to amend the provisions of the Regulations. Amendments shall enter into force within 7 days from the date of their publication on the Conference Website. However, with regard to services that are in progress, the version of the Regulations in force at the time of registration for the conference by the Participant shall apply.
6. The provisions of these Regulations form an integral part of the Conference Participation Application and are binding on all Participants.
